

FUNDSTRAT 2Q26 DAILY EARNINGS (EPS) UPDATE – 07/20/2026

- 86 companies are reporting this week.
- Of the 49 companies that have reported so far (10% of the S&P 500):
- Overall, 94% are beating estimates, and those that "beat" are beating by a median of 8%.
- Of the 6% missing, those are missing by a median of -1%.
- On the top line, overall results are beating estimates by a median of 4% and missing by a median of -1%, and 86% of those reporting are beating estimates.

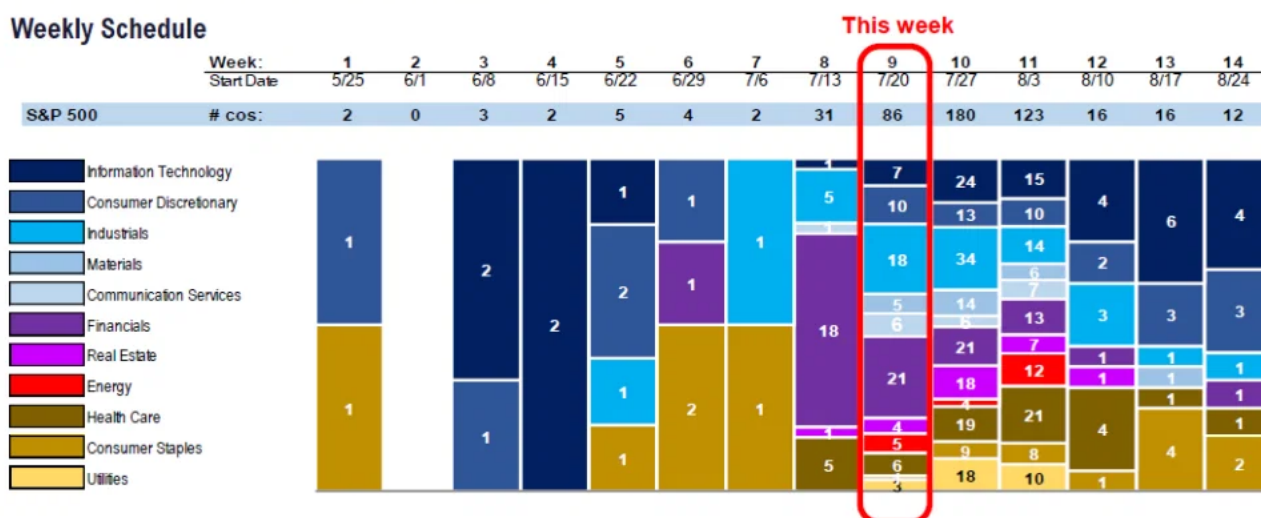

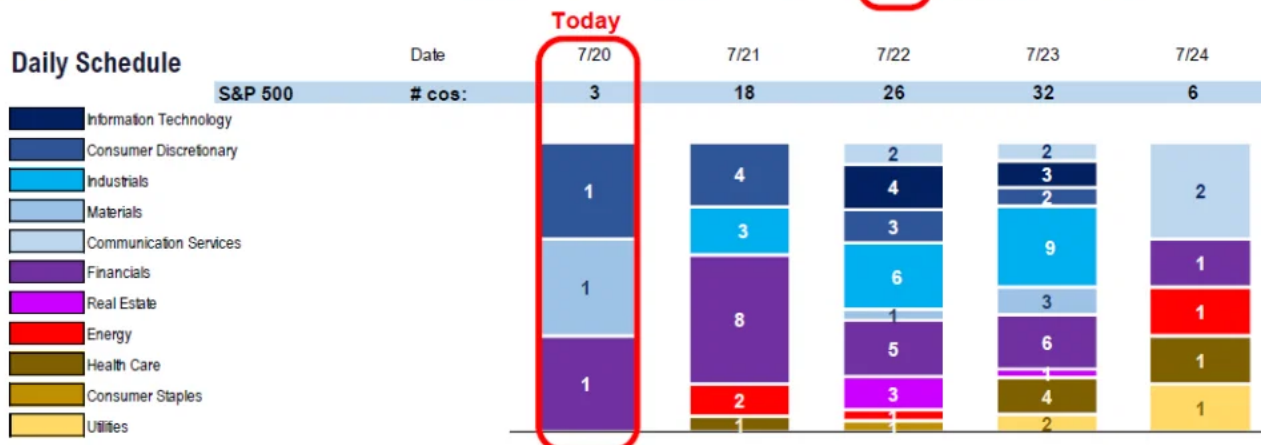
